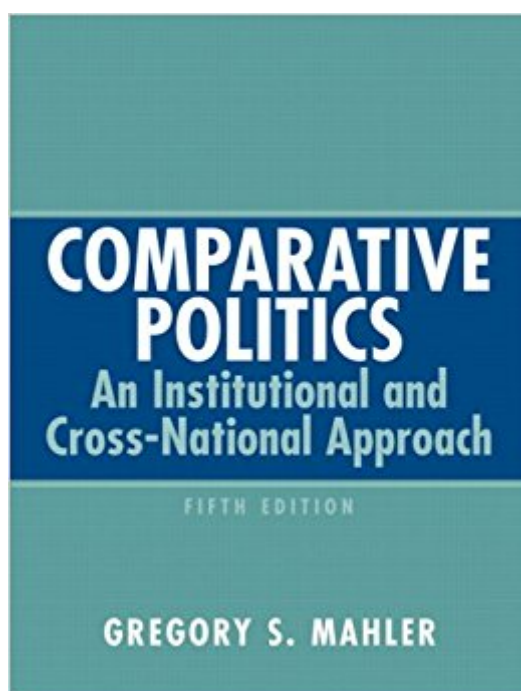


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Comparative Politics: An Institutional And Cross-National Approach (5th Edition)
