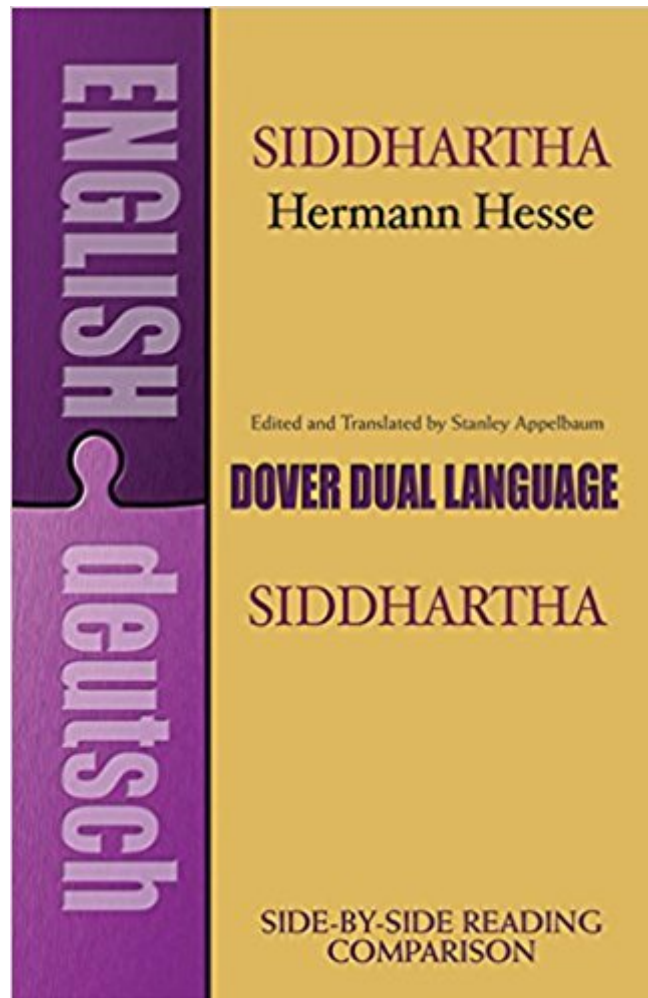




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Siddhartha (Dual-Language) (Dover Dual Language German)

Hesse's status as a writer of the first rank was cemented and enshrined with the publication of this work, I highly recommend this dual-language book not only for German-language students but for anyone wishing an elevated appraisal of the human condition.
