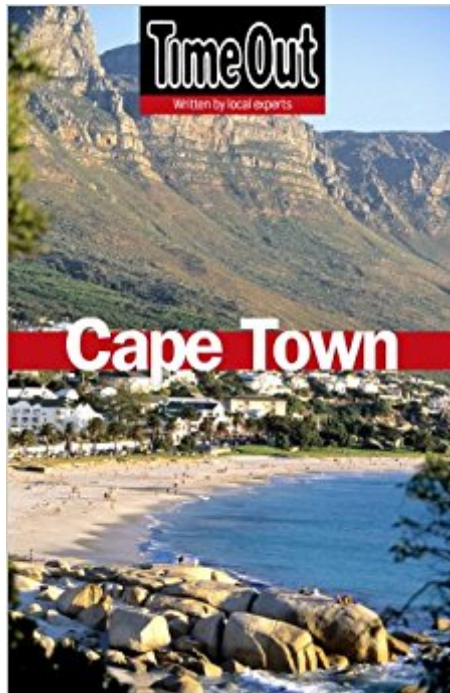


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Time Out Cape Town: Winelands And The Garden Route (Time Out Guides)

I think there is no perfect guide book for everyone, but this does a pretty good job. Not just with

popular visitor sights, hotels, and restaurants, but it has separate sections for shopping, galleries, entertainment, and kid's activities. I also liked that it goes into details about some of the more obscure museums. As a tour operator with Adventures Within Reach, I recommend this book for my clients visiting Cape Town and the surrounding areas.

It's pretty complete and informative, but no real revelations. The restaurant selection is pedestrian, so look elsewhere for much better restaurants.

I was skeptical about this book, particularly since I have no interest in the wine country. But with two five star reviews, I ordered it. I was amazed. Very well written. Covers everything. Great pictures. With our weight limits we will not take most of our guide books, but this one will accompany us. I gave the book to my wife.
