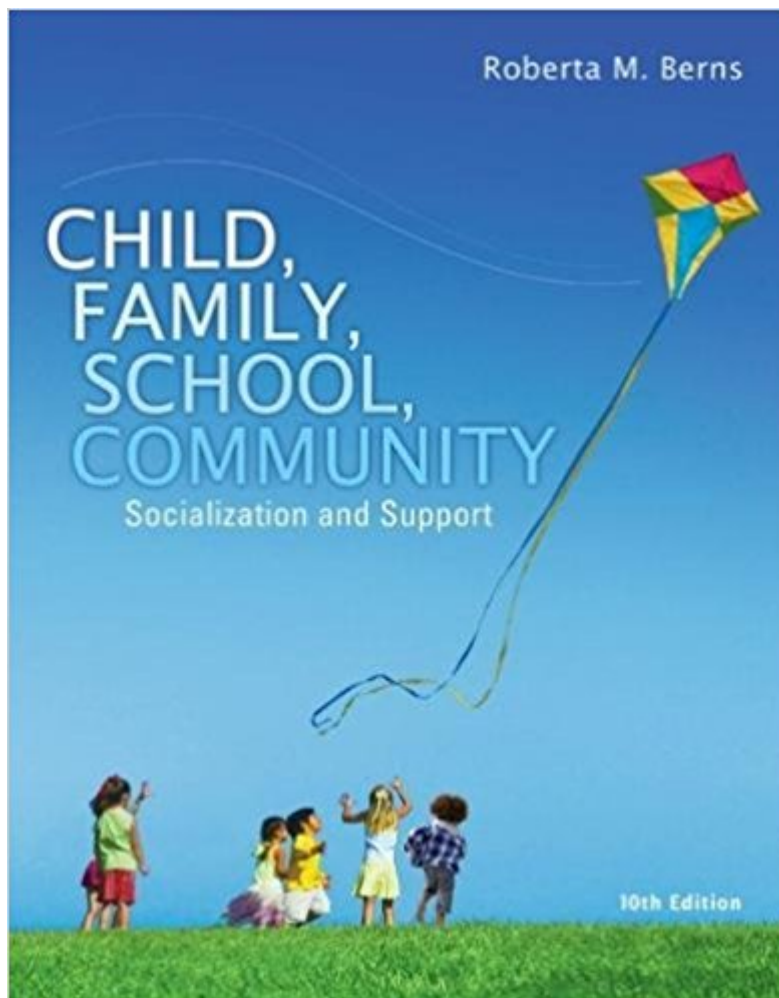




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Child, Family, School, Community: Socialization And Support (Standalone Book)
