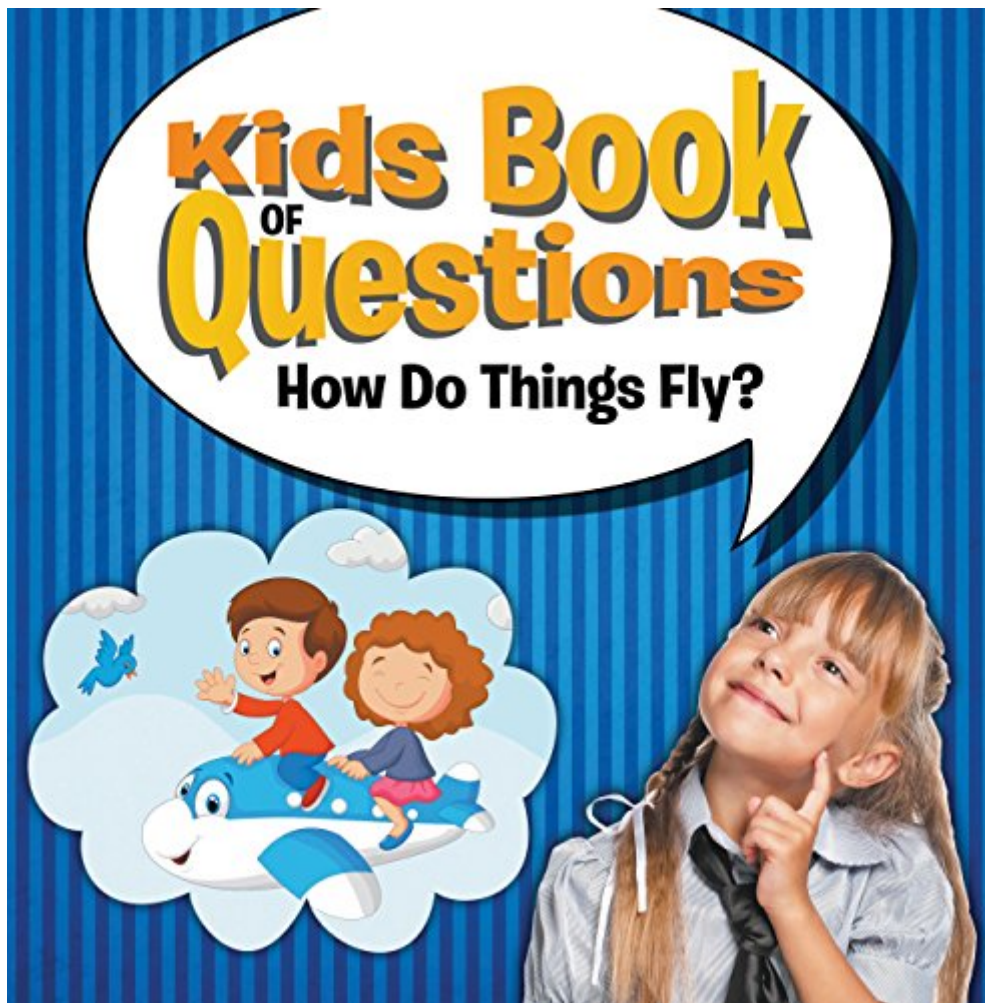

I reviewed another book by this publisher moments ago and I feel pasting the review for the other Kids book of questions is the best way to answer this book which I also read to my son. (he liked this book a bit more but the general review is identical.) my other review is: Okay so I have decided to go about my review a littler differently than I usually do. I am going to allow my child to give me their feedback and base the majority of my review on that since lets face it this book is intended to be reviewed by the actual reader not by a 30 something mother of 2. lol! So with that said I read this book to my 6 year old son and he seemed to just gobble it up. His usual wont sit still for a story self was literally glued to his seat and listening intently (which if I were reviewing as his mom would be a

HUGE plus) he had many MANY follow up questions for each question and their subsequent answers from the book (which if i were reviewing as his mom would kind of annoy me since I then in turn had to spend several minutes answering the questions with content not available in the book) He remained very curious and engaged from start to finish of the book (almost an hour and a half due to me having to have dialogue with him and answer all of his other questions) I asked him at the end of the book what his thoughts of the book were and to quote him he said " I loved it! can we read it again!" so obviously he loved the book and as such I would say it was a hit for the intended reader. Now here is where I will give my mom feedback. I found that the books intended audience is perfect only as long as an adult is available to answer the slew of follow up questions from the book. That is not necessarily a negative. I think this book offers an opportunity for the mother/Child to actively engage in dialogue and ends in relationship building. based on that fact I give a solid 4 stars and would purchase this book as well as the others by this same author, I would just do so with the knowledge that its an active Q & A style book, and gets their brains working so for sure not a bed time story type book. I am not a fan of this ebook. It doesn't answer the question "How do things fly?" at all. It has pictures of what flies, birds and insects and then goes into airplanes and balloons. It does give an explanation about why a hot air balloon flies but that's pretty much it. Also, it states that bird have wings to migrate and makes it seem like that's the only reason they have wings. They didn't mention anything about birds escaping predators or even the fact that some birds don't migrate. This seems more like a picture book for little kids than a question and answer book for elementary school children like I was expecting. In short, if you can get this ebook for free then you have nothing to loose, but I wouldn't want to pay for it. If you are in the market for books like this I would look into the book offers by the company who publishes this book, Speedy Publishing. There are so many books that are offered for free at different times. They are hit or miss if they are good or not though. So, I have a 7 year old who is not all that great with sitting still and reading when he has his allotted reading time during the day. (For school, he is required to read 20 minutes at least 5 days a week, however my husband and I ask that he reads 20 minutes every day, to help him improve.) This was a really interesting book for our family, and especially for me. We read this book together, with my 10 year old doing the reading (which impresses me every time). I don't remember learning even the bits about how things fly that was included in this book in my childhood. The illustrations were interesting, though in this book, the facts were more impacting. The book format really highlights the images and gives ample time for talking about the pictures. One spread has an image with a couple of sentences, then the next is simply an image. This repeats throughout the book and gives a great format for reading together. This book gives enough information to build a foundation, without being too in-depth or overwhelming. For us, it was random, for others, it would work well to start about learning of things that fly. I also think this book would work well for a classroom, because there is a lot of opportunity for talking about the pictures, or even completing a written or drawing assignment. Personally, as a homeschooler, I love books like this one that give valuable information in a quick and easy to digest format. Overall: Neat information, as quick or slow as you make it. We enjoyed it, and I think that most young children would be interested in reading this with their grown-up.
