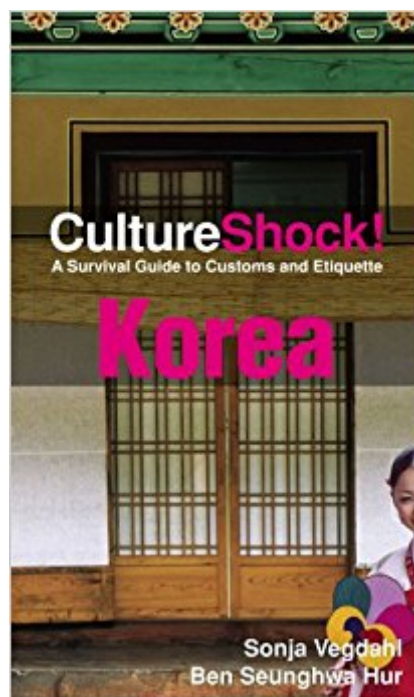




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CultureShock! Korea: A Survival Guide To Customs And Etiquette (Cultureshock Korea: A Survival Guide To Customs & Etiquette)

For being an introductory read, this book rocks my socks. I've read my share of culture books and resources but I feel that this book (namely, this edition) demystifies several Korean cultural idiosyncrasies in a clear way that is easy for anyone to understand. I applaud the authors for including a do-and-don't list. I feel that this helps clear up some questions left by other resources. It's true, most things Korean-related (as with any culture) usually aren't cut-and-dry and objective

enough to make a list but I still feel that the authors were tasteful and appropriate in their advice. This book kind of reminds me of a cross between Moon Handbooks - Korea and Culture Smart! Korea rolled into one. There's useful info on holidays, work ethic, psyche, travel destinations, and living abroad. This book deserves a look. It's a quick read with pleasing aesthetics and well-divided topics. You'll thank yourself later for this one.

This is a great book with a lot of information you need to know if you are going to Korea, or even if you're just interacting with a Korean here at home.

I am afraid I can hardly recommend the reading of "Culture Shock! Korea." I don't doubt the authors' exhaustive knowledge and experience in Korea. What I do question is their capacity to reflect it without falling into easy stereotypes that could outrightly be applied to most Asian societies. The volume repeats the same insights till the point of exhaustion. For instance, in the first pages it's already clear that drinking is a fixed feature in the life of Korean business people, what emerges in numerous chapters of the book, as the writers needed to fill in a particular number of pages at any cost. The book could somehow be useful for somebody who has never experienced embedding him/herself in an alien culture (maybe the case of the authors?) - otherwise, and as mentioned above, the reading endlessly points obvious remarks applicable to most of Asian

societies. Furthermore, the book heavily focuses on business people planning to move into South Korea, what makes several chapters unappealing to the non-business readers. I couldn't finish this superficial but necessary review without noting the slightly sexist tone of the volume - in spite of one of the authors being a woman. Throughout the book, it's assumed that foreign women living in South Korea are there in a mere wife role, what I found not only 'out-of-fashion' but plainly laughable

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
