

This book is mediocre. It might be useful to an extremely unversed writer. Another thing that disappointed me was that, although the title indicates that there will be alternatives provided. in numerous cases there were not. I guess I expected more. But without the "Look inside" feature, I

took a chance. Sometimes chances pay off; sometimes they don't.

Writing today tends to be overly elaborate which leads to too many words when fewer would suffice. This book, the Dictionary of Alternatives to Worn-Out Words and Phrases, helps you find a more professional, simpler way to write countless wordy phrases. You have to watch out though -- some of the phrases are so ingrained in our mind, you don't realize they are worn out. But this book will help you write more simply and more clearly. A useful purchase for anyone who has to write.
