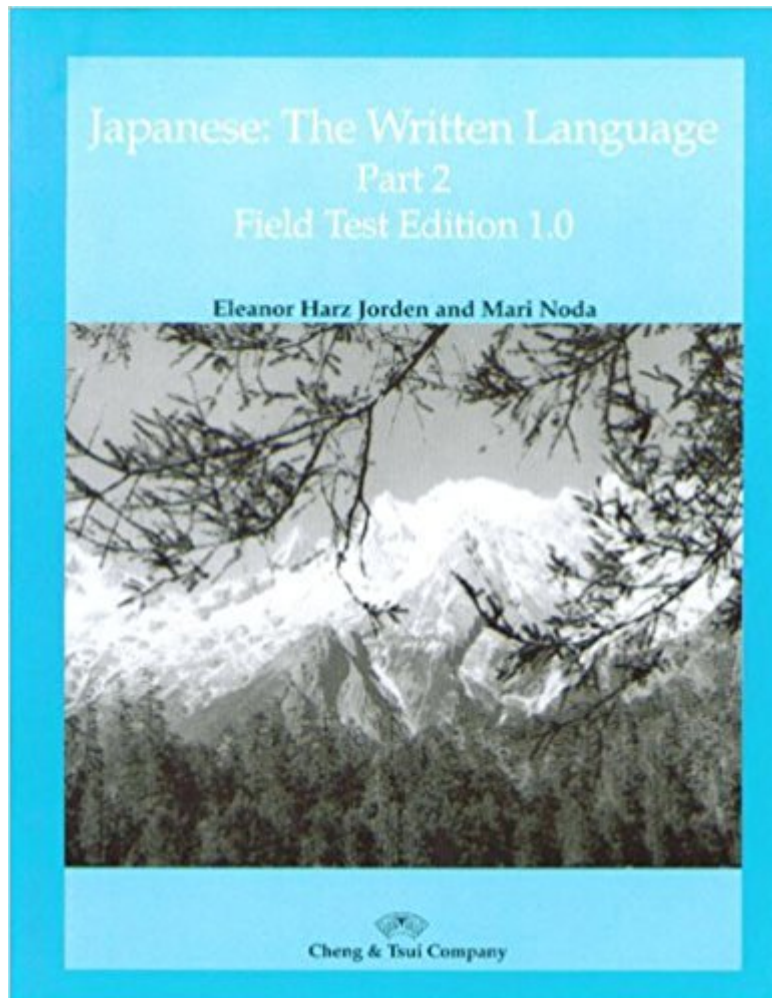




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Japanese: The Written Language, Part 2: Field Test Edition 1.0

The entire book in pure Kanji, which are symbols made of other symbols. There were little notes here and there to help memorize the characters and their structure, so very helpful. the book itself is really useful, I think. I've found one other kanji book equally useful, but that doesn't include practice sentences, stroke order nor 'other readings' for characters. If you are trying to learn Japanese on your own, this is a fantastic resource (but this is, after all, part II), as well as it's counterpart "Japanese: The Spoken Language".

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
