This travel guide left a lot to be desired. They omitted some pretty important places, and their recommendations were not terribly clear. I ended up purchasing the Frommers Guide in addition to this one, was very pleased with it, and took that one with me on my trip instead.

I bought this book for my second trip to New Orleans. I had previously been pre-Katrina. The Fodor's guide has everything correct and down to which shops reopened when and how much damage was done in each area. A must have for your next trip to New Orleans.

My husband and I took a trip to NOLA in January of this year (2011). Before we went we purchased the Fodor's 2011 guide book. What a waste of money! The first mistake in the book was the cost of the cab into the city. The 2011 book said that the fee was \$28 and all over the airport it was posted at \$33 as set by the city. When we went to use the book for information about various sites - there was no info re:times that places were open for operation. Several occasions we tried restaurants that were recommended and the specialty food items listed were not on the menu. I had counted on this book as the Fodor name usually means excellence. In this case I feel that the new edition was the old edition with a new cover. I was extremely disappointed. As a result of this experience, I went onto the Frommer's site at the hotel and found much more accurate and usable information. Next time it is Frommers's for me - don't bother with Fodor!
