

If you are considering visiting, please plan for one week minimum of staying in Canada. Canadian Rockies are located in the Canadian provinces of Alberta and British Columbia. They comprise the Canadian segment of the North American Rocky Mountains Range. They have numerous high peaks and ranges and much of them are protected by Canada National parks and UNESCO as World Heritage Sites. Canadian and American Rockies combined together, stretch more than 4,830 km(3,000 miles). The most visited part of Canadian Rockies stretches approximately 725 km(450 miles) in length and it rarely exceeds 80 km to 90 km (50 miles) in width, but the places and location one can see are beyond of our imagination. Very nice book. It makes a great keepsake of our trip to the Canadian Rockies last month.

I will be traveling to the Canadian Rockies in a few months. Based on the five star reviews, I thought this book would provide great photos and information to help me plan my trip. I hesitated at the price of the book, but I purchased it anyway because the reviews were so positive. I thought this book would be a great investment for my upcoming vacation. I was so wrong. Of course, I knew this was a paperback book. That's just fine. What is not fine is the quality of the photos in the book and the small (almost blurry) print. I compared the print of this book to the print the Lonely Planet Banff, Jasper & Glacier travel book which I also own. The size of the print in both books is about the same, but the print is so much clearer in the Lonely Planet book. Moving on from the overall look of the book, let's talk about content. The spelling and grammatical errors in this book are crazy for a "professionally" printed book. I lost count at how many times the book uses the word "trial" instead of "trail". I nearly lost my mind on page 56 of this book where, in a section about Jasper, it states, "When you arrive, feel free to WONDERING its main street, but keep in mind that if you drive around its forest, you will almost certainly spot some of the wildlife activities." I may wander the streets of Jasper, but I'm wondering why I bought this book. The information provided in this book is OK if you can get past everything that I mentioned above. My rating for this book would have been one star, but I bumped it to two stars based on the information. If you are thinking of buying this book before your trip to the Canadian Rockies, do yourself a favor and buy a different book. You can buy two books (Lonely Planet and Frommer's) for the price I paid for this one. If you are thinking of buying this as a souvenir after your vacation to the Canadian Rockies, please make your own

Shutterfly photo book with your own photos. I guarantee it will look better than this book.

I am now reading a third book from the author. I am living in Australia and reading books about a different places is the form of traveling which I can currently afford. This book is very informative and has got beautiful pictures (my wife and me are amateur photographers) . What I honestly like about the book is that you can really use if you are traveling. The author will describe the place and then back it up with photos. Printing is good quality. (it's not that shiny thick paper which has got a lots of glare reflection when you read it not to mentioned the price attached to such a book). Now we are really considering with my wife to start seriously saving and head of to see it in person.

I bought this book expecting excellent photos and information. The photos are mostly "snapshot" quality and the reproduction (book) quality is below average. I considered returning it, but there is some valuable information about the region. Definitely a disappointing book on all levels.

Are you planning to go to the Canadian Rockies? Or are you still dreaming about that? In that case this book is right for you to make your dream becoming true. If you have never thought about going to Canadian Rockies than you just need to look at these photos in this book and you'll know that you should be starting packing, you just feel that you want to be there and see that beauty by you.
