

Although it is mostly written for the education of a therapist, I was still able to gain some useful knowledge for my profession, as well. It is quite informative and contains some information that is not included in standard psych texts. New diagnoses such as internet addiction is reviewed as well as information on infertility and how it affects one's mental health. Although it is not a typical psychiatric text -- and, by this I mean it does not review standard mental illnesses such as Schizophrenia or Bipolar Disorder, etc. -- it does provide a lot of information regarding health problems and how they affect one's mental state. I would recommend this book for someone who is a beginner in the field of psychiatry.
