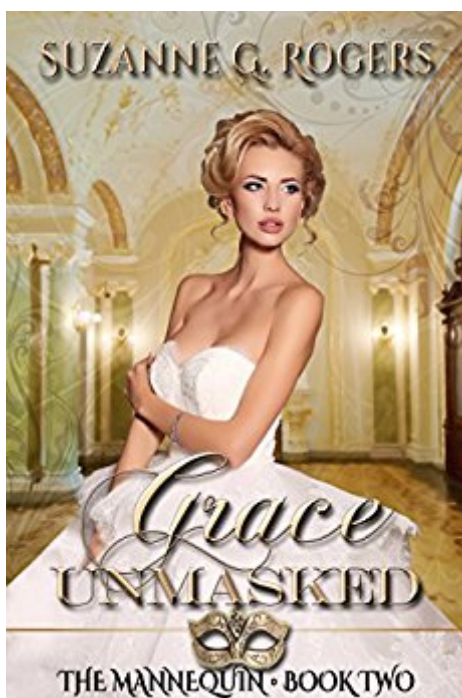

After tentatively beginning The Mannequin, Book 1 and thoroughly enjoying it, I couldn't imagine that book 2 would surpass the story of Rosamund and Aubrey. Book 2 was a delightful surprise, full

of satisfying comedy and drama, without any raunchiness. These stories are like watching an intelligent, sweet movie, the kind that makes you want to rewind and re-watch. S. Rogers paints her characters in technicolor and leaves me wanting more.

This book is wonderful. I call it the hysterical romance. I have laughed so much while reading this. A true joy to read. I hope there are more to follow in this series.

I have definitely found a new favorite author. Ms Rogers works are well written, with interesting characters and a fine grasp of the English language.

I personally like the author's ability to tell a story in a straight forward fashion where all the elements in story line make sense. I found myself pulled into the story line and really thought more of the 1930 movies of class divides and the romantic comedies associated with bridging the gap (which seem relevant today). I also hope for a third book as two character were left unresolved.

A good follow-up to the first book. Secondary characters, Lord Henley and Joe Fiddick, from the first book take center stage. A heroine rises above her circumstances, but her future is threatened by her past. Conflicts and a few twists pull the story forward. Grace and Lord Henley are likable characters but their romance is a bit flat, not very compellingly. I liked Joe Fiddick from both books. His rise and fall was the most interesting. Left to wonder about Vivian and Inspector McNaughton,.

I rated Grace Unmasked a five star rating because I could hardly put it down. The characters were instantly loved with the exception of Lord Renald whom you will detest. This is one book I'll reread several times.
