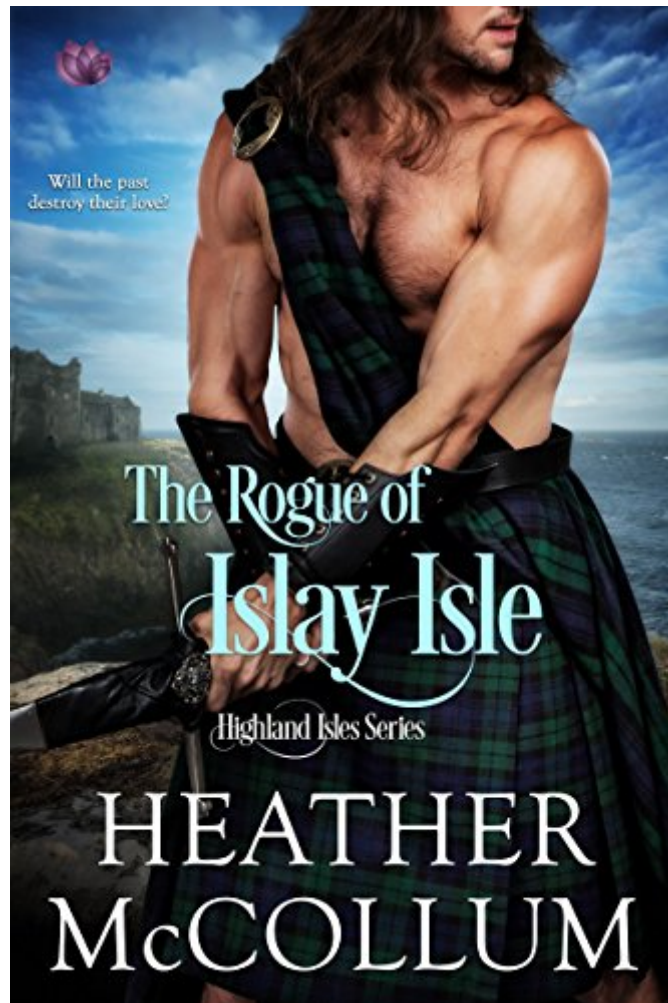




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The Rogue Of Islay Isle (Highland Isles)

Though it easily stands on its own, it was nice to have a bit of follow-up from the first in the series, 'The Beast of Aros Castle.' The book follows Rose, a beautiful and mysterious woman who has washed upon the shores of Islay with no memories of who or what she is. As passion mounts between her and the castle's sexy warrior/Laird, so do tensions with in the claim over fear of reprisal from the English soldiers stalking their shores. And as memories finally begin to surface, Rose fears that her training, alone, could earn a ride back to the French Court with a heavy rope tied once again around her tender throat.
