This book was written and published in England and you need to be aware that many of the common names of plants are vastly different than here in the U.S. Also, hardiness and heat zones are not mentioned, so you need to know your plant materials and their zones. I use Dr. Dirr's books as my final reference for all woody shrubs and trees.
