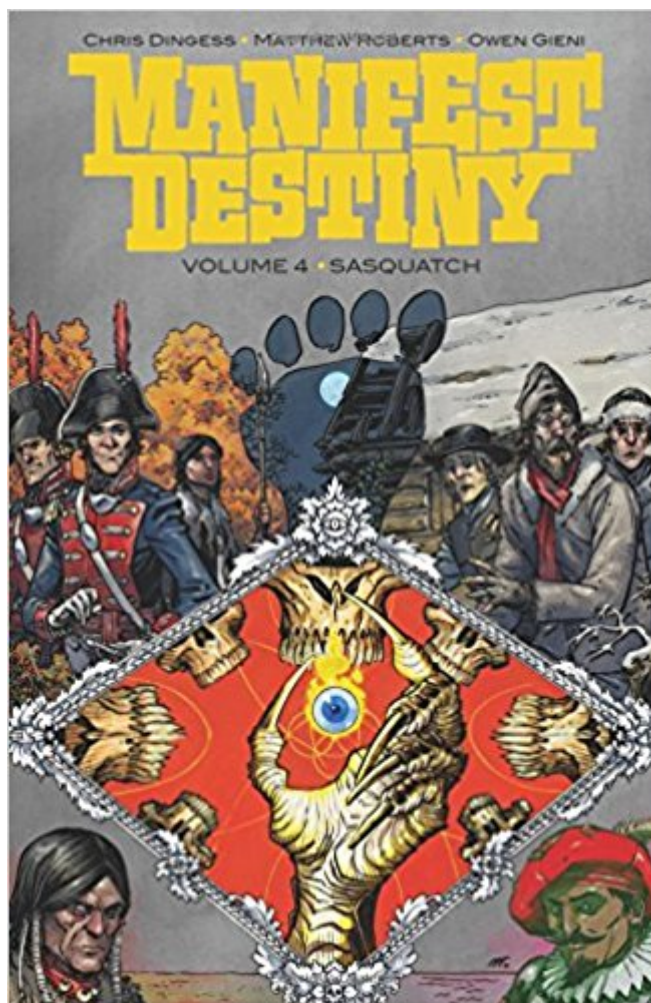

4.5 stars. This is one of my favorite current series. The writing (plot, characterizations, dialogue) and art (facial expressions, costumes, scenery, backgrounds) are all fantastic. In this volume, we learn of a previous group of explorers from 1801 (Lewis and Clark started in 1804, and that is the year in this story as well). Their story and their encounters with monsters runs parallel to our protagonists. It is excellent and interesting storytelling. Captain Helm, the 2nd in command of the previous party, is the main character in this volume. His journey and reactions are fascinating. Dingess hasn't fallen off a bit. This series is outstanding.

I really enjoy this series because I find the juxtaposition of fantasy and historical characters to be really wonderful, and the art is amazing. I've been following the series since the first book and each has been fun and intriguing.

I love the premise behind this series. The story and artwork are well done too. This is a great read.

Dingess still delivers the intriguing blend of noir, sci-fi, and historical fiction that one expects from the Manifest Destiny saga.

This comic series continues with the fantasised tale of the Lewis-Clark expedition which opened up the United States: they find more fantastical creatures which they need to defeat: the title of the volume "Sasquatch" gives that away. This fourth volume builds on previous volumes, introducing new characters from an expedition several years earlier. Interestingly made and well-illustrated, this series gets the balance right between historical accuracy and plain fantasy fun but alternating every few pages with the flashbacks to the earlier expedition is annoying to say the least. More volumes will follow.

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
