

I, too, have read many business books. This one is somehow different, somehow it connects with people where others do not. I pay my associates to read something about business for thirty minutes at the start of each day, to teach them things they did not know, remind them of the things they do know, and to get them focussed on their priorities of the day. Brackman has some good ideas. There is some good wisdom to help your business and your life and a great connection to traditional Jewish ethics. Sadly much of the book reads like he's run out of things to say and is desperately waffling to fill space. At times he drifts into some new-age airy fairy stuff that has no grounding in either Judaism or business. Even with all that, the good ideas he has are worth the time to read this book and even the points he presents poorly are still presented well enough to get you thinking in a productive direction.

I initially read a sample of the book downloaded to my Kindle and was sold on the concept at the first sentence -- "Why have so many Jews been successful at business?" The authors continue on to document the disproportionate success of Jewish people, ultimately attributing it to a few basic teachings from the Torah that have become staples of the Jewish culture. Surprisingly, many of the concepts seem to be common sense (conquer fear, find your passion, don't make emotional decisions, etc.), but the authors explain the spiritual principles that act as the foundation for success with specific examples from the Torah and other ancient Jewish teachings. There are three features of the book that are particularly helpful. Each section ends with a specific insight (application) for business and an insight for our personal life from the teaching. Each chapter ends with guided meditation to solidify the application and understanding of the principle. Finally, there are real-world examples throughout the book that serve as examples of the concept from which we can pattern our own thinking on our business. For the most part, readers will not be surprised at the nine principles taught. What is surprising is the ability of the authors to enable the reader to take ownership of the concepts and integrate them into every aspect of life and business. That is the real value of this book.
