

I feel like this book really helps in bringing the family together and getting everyone involved inBible study.

I really like this. It's easy enough to tailor to younger or a bit older kids (4-10), and the verses generate great discussion. If you aren't using the same translation, some of the questions don't work exactly the same. This definitely isn't a study for a parent who doesn't already have some Biblical knowledge of their own under their belt. I find the scriptures alone, before I even get to the questions the studies pose, have given my children and I great discussions that are strengthening my desire for wisdom! I feel like the questions themselves really may not work as well if you have a different translation you're using, but overall I really like this study.

I got this as a Summer reading project for my Grandson, age 7, and I. Well worth the time invested in him! Easy to read and understanding.

My children and I really enjoyed this study. We worked through it as a family and all agreed we'd learned some wonderful truths from it. I definitely plan on ordering another one from this series. It was well worth it and so enjoyable.
