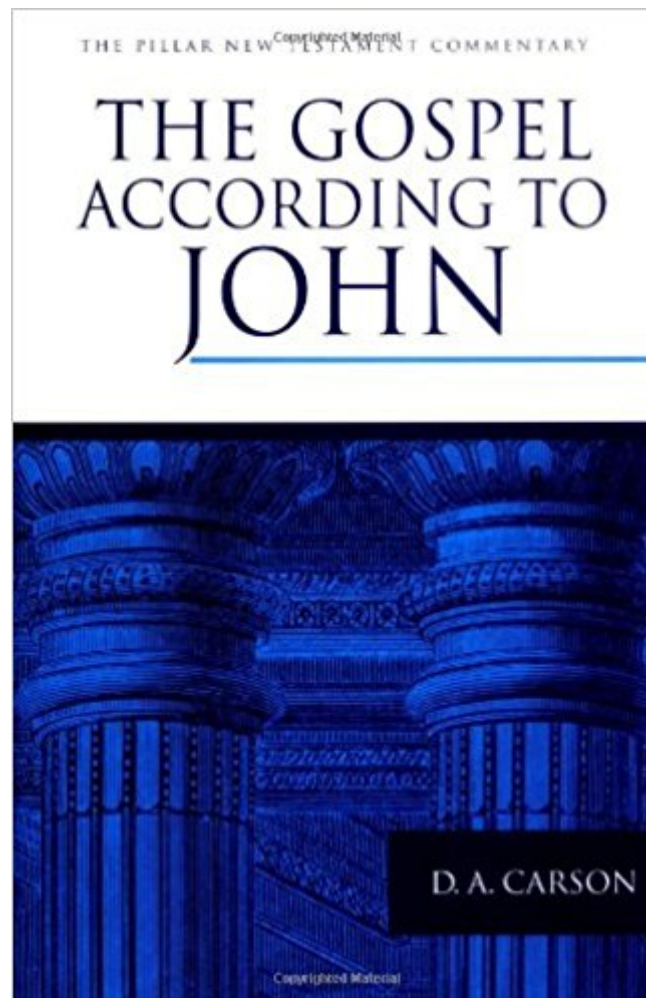




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The Gospel According To John (The Pillar New Testament Commentary (PNTC))

This book seeks above all to explain the text of John's Gospel to those who minister the Word of God to others, either by preaching or by leading Bible studies; however, the commentary is also designed for use by the informed layperson for purposes of personal growth in edification and understanding.

I am currently preaching through John's Gospel on Sunday mornings and this is my go-to commentary every week. The Gospel of John is the very center of Carson's wheelhouse and I'm so glad that Pillar chose him to write this.

The vast array of sources referenced gives the reader confidence that Dr. Carson has comprehensively interacted with the material. He is fair in his treatment of opposing interpretive views, yet definite in his own conclusions. The flow of thought is coherent and the writing style articulate, although I admit consulting my English dictionary once or twice. Because his treatment of the Greek text demonstrates scholarly precision, yet does not require knowledge of the language, I recommend this commentary to laymen and academics alike. Dr. Carson adheres to a historical-grammatical method of hermeneutics that well supports his evangelical outlook.
