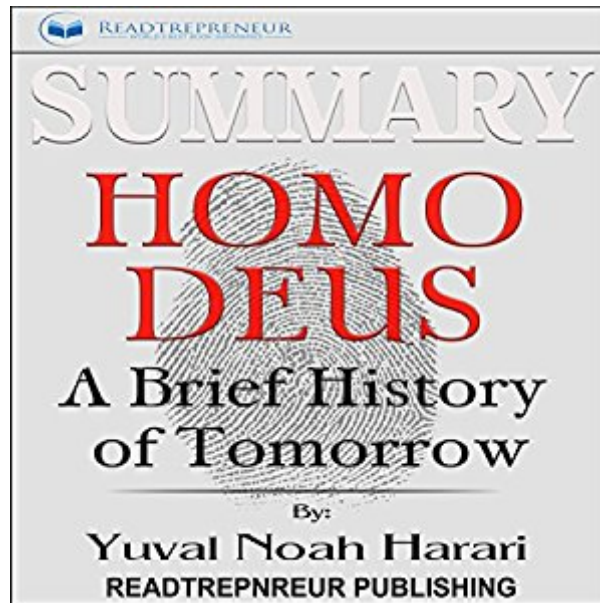

It elaborates on the fascinating concept of "intersubjective reality", whereby concepts that are shared in our collective imagination have great power to shape our objective reality; examples given include money, corporations, pop-culture brands, and religions and I found the author's arguments to be compelling in Sapiens; in Homo Deus I felt factual backing for the author's positions for our future was not as convincing and it must read till the end.
