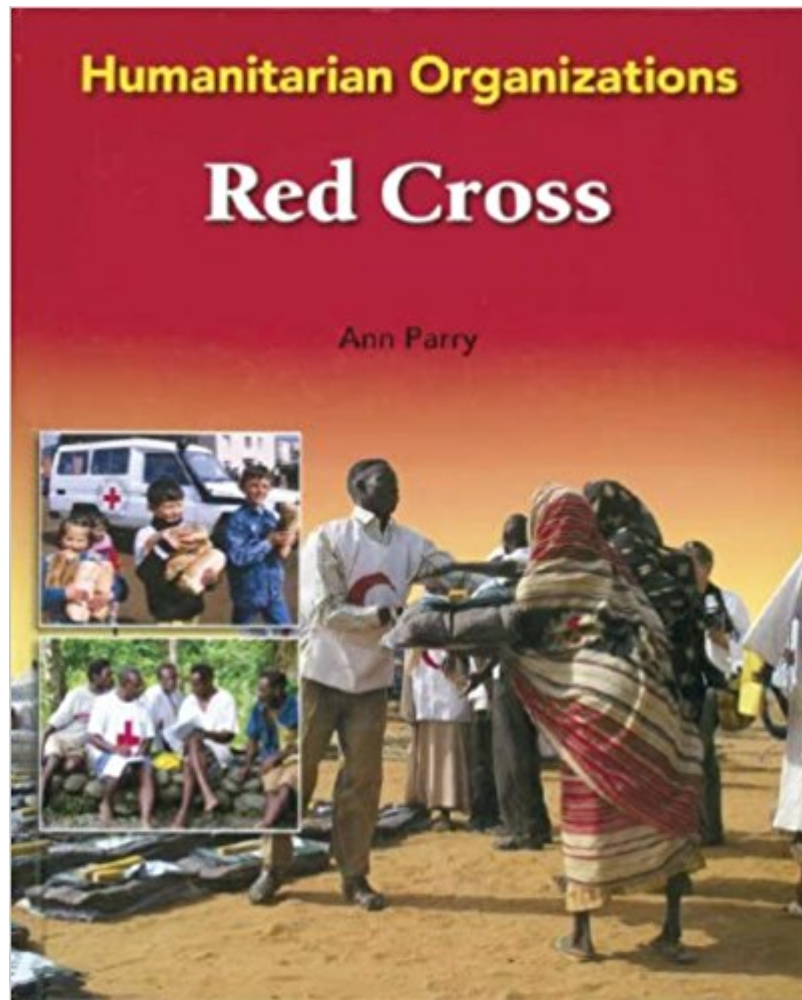

Gr. 4-6. The Humanitarian Organizations series introduces middle-schoolers to groups such as Greenpeace, Doctors without Borders, and, much in the news of late, the Red Cross. Chapters highlight the organizations' history, their response to disasters and conflict, and the work of individuals: two-page spreads introducing a psychologist, an engineer, and a youth worker. The pages are busy, with photos, sidebars, call-out information, and boxed text. Some of this creates repetition, and in the effort to keep the language simple, the definitions at times lack clarity and precision. In one place, it's noted that Muslim countries prefer their own red-crescent symbol to the red cross. In another, it's noted that countries with non-Christian religions such as Islam and Hinduism do not use the cross because it is a Christian symbol--although there's no explanation of the Hindus preference for a crescent.
