

My first impression isn't very good. The book came in good condition but the binding was cheap (not the seller's fault). The book's content overall is a bit dry and extremely prolix, that said I realize it's a textbook and not a novel however the author and editor could have made an effort to make the book a bit more entertaining (education and entertainment aren't mutually exclusive) or at least been have attempted to be more concise. As others have mentioned the price is set too high for the book, none of the diagrams are in color and are of low quality. If you're a student and it's required reading for a course I'd suggest asking your professor to consider using a different book/ course material, if you're a professor I'd suggest you look elsewhere for a book that would better suit your students needs.
