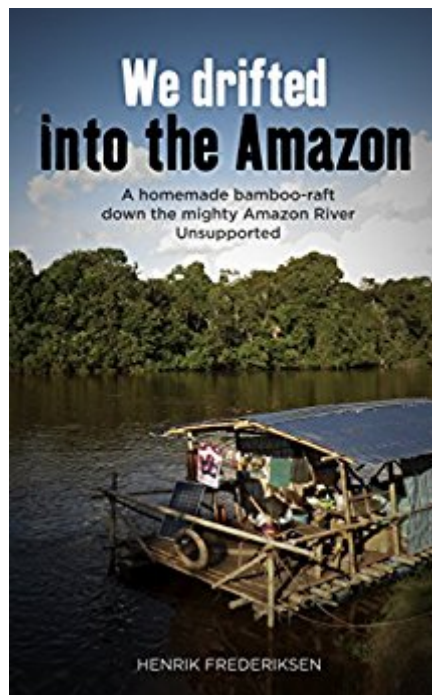




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We Drifted Into The : A Homemade Bamboo Raft Down The Mighty River, Unsupported
