

I never wanted to speak in tongues or fall down. But I did want salvation through Jesus and the Holy Spirit to teach me. Now I have confidence that if the Lord needed me to speak in a different tongue, He would be there to do it. But it would be Him speaking and not me. My worries are over. Now all I have to do is be obedient to Him.

This is definitely one of the best reads on the baptism and work of the Holy Spirit out there. It seems that John Stott was a cessationist but acknowledged the spirit's power. He believed that prophecy and tongues are not around today and that the baptism of the Holy Spirit occurs at salvation. If you are looking for a good book on the Holy Spirit, read this one.

This book, while a shorter read (just over 100 pages), is a great resource for getting into the nuances of the Holy Spirit and His work. Both concise and enjoyable to read, Stott dives into a lot of Scripture to show the foundation of how the Holy Spirit works in and through us. If anyone is studying this topic academically or needs clarity amidst their own Christian faith, I highly recommend this book.
