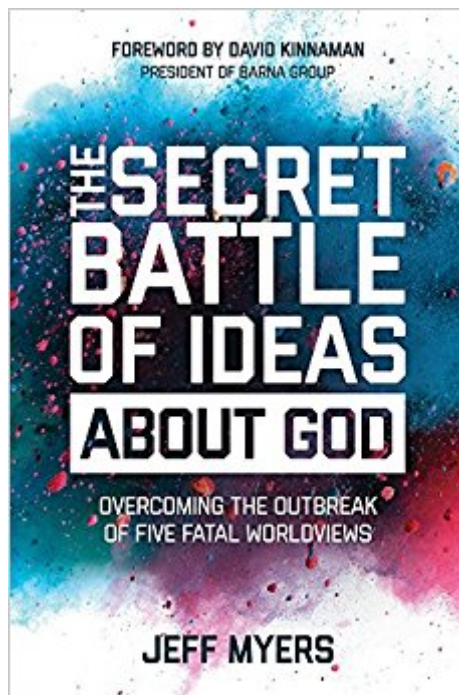

Few books on culture and worldview offer much in the way of tangible use. The Secret Battle of

Ideas is a great way for me to think about what worldviews actually do in shaping how I live in the world. I work at a Christian boarding school in Fergus Falls, MN that has over 70 countries represented in any given year. There are a lot of different ideas and views of the world floating around. What the Secret Battle has done for me is given me a better framework to erect in asking what worldviews and ideas actually do for us. I appreciated how this book points the worldviews to the point of salvation, asking us where, how, and in what we find our identity and ultimately salvation in. This was an accessible read that was fun and uplifting. While I didn't need my dictionary, and rarely used Siri to help me on concepts, this book did open some deeper thinking into worldview analysis while also keeping the focus on Jesus Christ. I recommend this to anyone looking for a low-entry way to talk about worldview with students, friends, or coworkers (because we all know that your coworkers aren't your friends...)
